P.B.I.S

Davidson Elementary has adopted the Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) approach to student discipline. As a substitute teacher in our building, please be aware of the following:

1. Our primary goal is to prevent discipline problems. To do this we must... a) Teach, model, and expect students to display R.O.A.R. R-Respectful; O-On Task; A-Always Safe; R-Responsible

b) Treat students in a positive and respectful way—avoid yelling, belittling students, or using sarcasm.

c) Maintain effective supervision of students at all times.



d) Expect students to follow all established routines and procedures (they are posted all over the school for all to

see). Know the expected procedures for the classroom, halls, restrooms, and cafeteria. When students fail to follow the expected procedure, have them repeat the procedure correctly.

e) Reinforce positive behavior.

f) Frequently point out and show appreciation for appropriate behavior.

R.O.A.R Tickets

- What we use at Davidson to recognize students who are exhibiting positive behavior.
- All staff regularly use Dragon tickets *All* students have opportunity to be recognized for good choices, even the most challenging students.

Students who earn at least one R.O.A.R. ticket will receive a Dragon Notice to take home. Only ONE Dragon Notice goes home each day a student earns R.O.A.R. tickets.



Students can be earn a R.O.A.R. ticket by exhibiting one of the 4 positive behaviors:



<u>Three Second,</u> Three Step Process

- 1. State expectation
- 2. State skill
- 3. Give the ticket

Example:

Jose, thank you for being Respectful by waiting to be called on during carpet time.

At the end of the day R.O.A.R. tickets are collected and sent to the office for various daily, weekly and monthly raffles. P.B.I.S. monthly assemblies tare held and parents are encouraged to attend.
